



Intermediate/Advanced Glass Casting Workshop – 3 days

This course is aimed at students who have already attended Techniques of Glass Casting – 3 day Workshop with Di Tocker.

Workshop Sessions

Day 1	Saturday	9.30am – 4pm
Day 2	Sunday	9.30am – 4pm
Day 3	Saturday	9.30am – 4pm (approx 2-3 weeks later)

You will be able to:

- Mould larger objects (up to 3kg glass / 0.85g wax – if you desire)
- Cast 2 objects. Note: Maximum wax height is 300mm.
- Mix casting colours if required.
- Spend more time finishing your glass pieces.

Wax Modelling

- Di recommends you work on your wax in your own time prior to the course.
- The first day of the course is focused on wax, however it is easy to eat up a lot of time on finishing and feeders.
- Your wax will be returned to you after steaming.

Workshop Fee

\$400 - this includes tuition, use of tools, grinding grits.

Includes tea and coffee and morning tea. Please bring your own lunch.

Materials

You will need to pay for wax, glass, moulding materials, pots, kiln space, (saw cuts and acid dipping if required). Grinding grits are included in the tuition cost. Please see the separate price list for materials and studio costs.

Approximate cost to cast 2 pieces 2 kg each = \$220 (estimate only)
